Stewards viewed the replay of the trial re the actions of MONSTER MISSION (4) outwardly towards HEAR FOOTSTEPS (6) affording MONSTER MISSION (4) the benefit of the doubt regarding marring. MONSTER MISSION (4) will need to re trial for clearance of the 9/8/20 unsatisfactory performance endorsement and for the purposes of clearing the wearing of an offside blinker. | | |

MONSTER MISSION (4) was trialling to clear an unsatisfactory performance endorsement at Richmond 9/8/20 and to be authorised by stewards to race with an offside blinker. **MONSTER MISSION (4)** will need to successfully undertake subsequent steward trial/s to overcome the unsatisfactory performance endorsement of 9/8/20 and the wearing of an offside blinker ongoing.
