Stewards permitted HAPPY WELCOME – Race 2 No. 8, to compete under GAR 39(2). The greyhound last started on 1/8/20 at the weight of 25.9kgs, and was presented tonight at 27.0kgs.

WINNER	ZIPPING VELVET(5)		
PERFORMANCE/ INCIDENTS	<p>Stewards observed MISS BUMP(2) become fractious when being boxed, requiring the assistance of the starter, delaying the start somewhat.</p> <p>MISS BUMP(2) and ZIPPING VELVET(5) were slow to begin. BLAZING SNAP(8) in crossing to the lead approaching the turn into the back straight checked WYATT ASH(4) and MISS GABRIELLE(6), with MISS GABRIELLE(6), losing ground hampering MISS BUMP(2), MANILA KING(3), and ZIPPING VELVET(5). BRIGHT SPARK(1) galloped on the back of WYATT ASH(4) in the back straight, causing both runners to lose ground, hampering MISS BUMP(2), MANILA KING(3), and MISS GABRIELLE(6). BLAZING SNAP(8) eased badly soon after entering the home straight when holding a substantial lead. As a consequence of the actions of BLAZING SNAP(8), ZIPPING VELVET(5) has momentarily lost focus on the lure, and reacted by inwardly marring BLAZING SNAP(8).</p> <p>BLAZING SNAP(8) was vetted with no incapacitation period imposed.</p> <p>With regards to the actions of BLAZING SNAP(8) in the home straight, Stewards invoked GAR 69A(1) for failing to pursue the lure. As this was the greyhounds 1st offence, BLAZING SNAP(8) was suspended at The Gardens for 28 days, and is required to undertake a satisfactory trial prior to re-nomination per GAR 69A(2)(a).</p> <p>With respect to the actions of ZIPPING VELVET(5) in the home straight, although satisfied head contact did occur with BLAZING SNAP(8), Stewards have determined that the actions of BLAZING SNAP(8) had attributed to the waywardness of ZIPPING VELVET(5), and took no further action, other than to highlight the incident to the kennel representative Mr Vodagaz</p> <p>Stewards endorsed the registration certificate of MISS BUMP(2) Hard To Box.</p>

CURRINGA MISS(2) was checked off the heels of JET PROPELLED(3) approaching the first turn, causing JET PROPELLED(3) to lose ground sharply, colliding with MAXIMUM MULWEE(5) and HAPPY WELCOME(8). From this incident, MAXIMUM MULWEE(5) fell, and CURRINGA MISS(2) and HAPPY WELCOME(8) both lost significant ground. FUNKY ROBBO(4) continued to race wide approaching the home turn. BO FOCUS(1) was checked off the heels of JET PROPELLED(3) at the home turn. CURRINGA MISS(2) was vetted with no incapacitation period imposed. MAXIMUM MULWEE(5) was vetted and was found to have soreness in the off side hip support. 5 Days Incapacitation Certificate issued. HAPPY WELCOME(8) was vetted with no incapacitation period imposed.</p>
