Stewards questioned trainer H Sarkis with regards to the nomination and subsequent scratching of Congressional from tonight's 720m event – Race 4. Stewards queried Mr Sarkis regarding the greyhounds ability to run 720m, with it's only win being over 330m, and having not raced for in excess of 3 weeks. Mr Sarkis informed Stewards that CONGRESSIONAL had injured itself in an emptying yard at home, and would likely be sidelined for an extended period. Mr Sarkis further reasoned that the greyhound doesn't have sufficient speed to be competitive over sprint distances, and once fit again will persevere with a staying campaign, reasoning that CONGRESSIONAL may be able to find an early lead in a staying race, encouraging the greyhound to chase a little keener. Stewards noted Mr Sarkis' remarks.

Stewards interviewed trainer M Buckley after the last race, with respect to the delay in starting Race 8 tonight, brought about with the boxing of WHITEY SPHERE. Present during this interview was the Club starter Mr Patman. Stewards replayed the boxing of the greyhounds to Mr Buckley and then took verbal submissions from Mr Patman, and Steward N Meyn who was behind the boxes. Stewards have had ongoing concerns over the past few weeks at Wentworth Park where Mr Buckley has been racing consistently, that a growing trend had developed, whereby what was observed tonight was becoming repetitious. Stewards determined to declare WHITEY SPHERE Hard To Box, however will not be endorsing any kennelmates similarly. Stewards will continue to monitor the boxing methods of Mr Buckley, with Mr Buckley informed that any subsequent indiscretions, causing the start of the race to be delayed, will result in Mr Buckley being barred from parading his runners.
